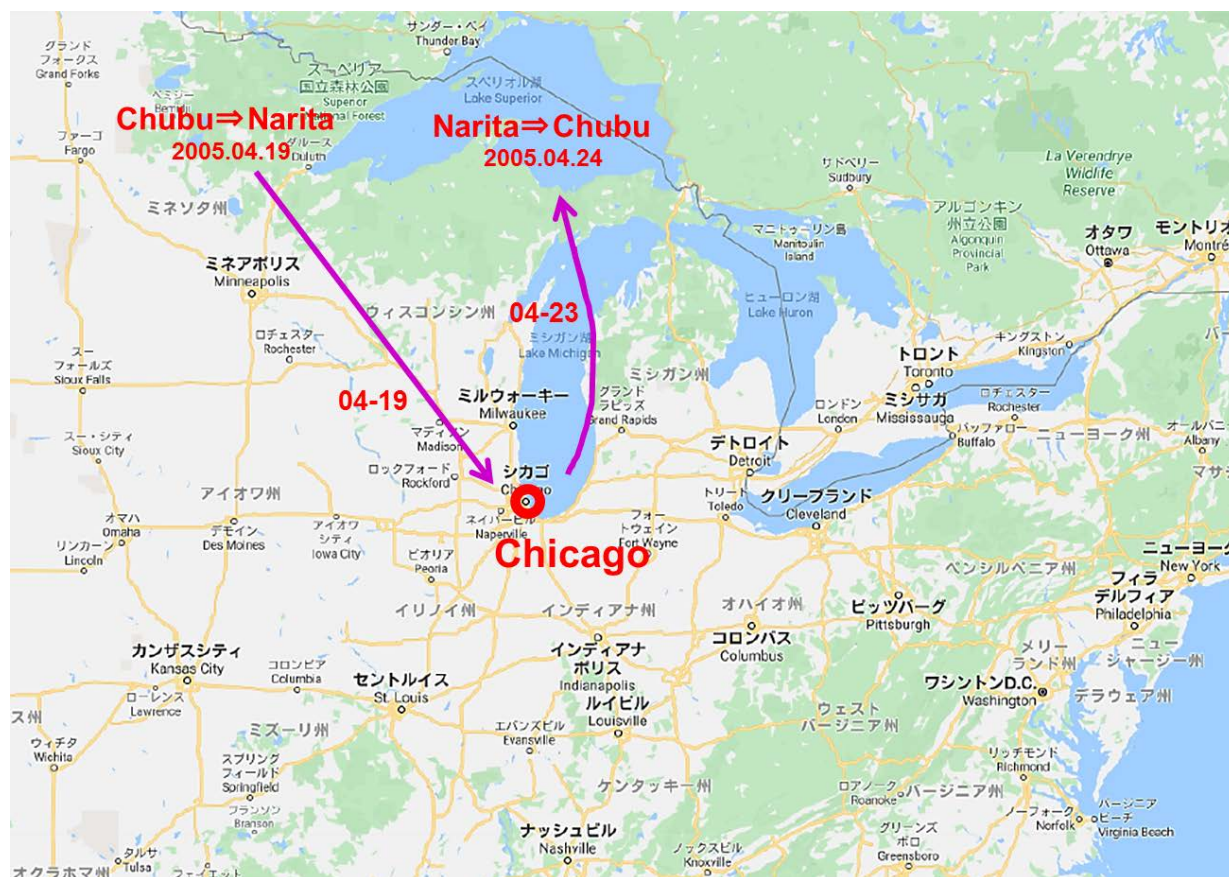

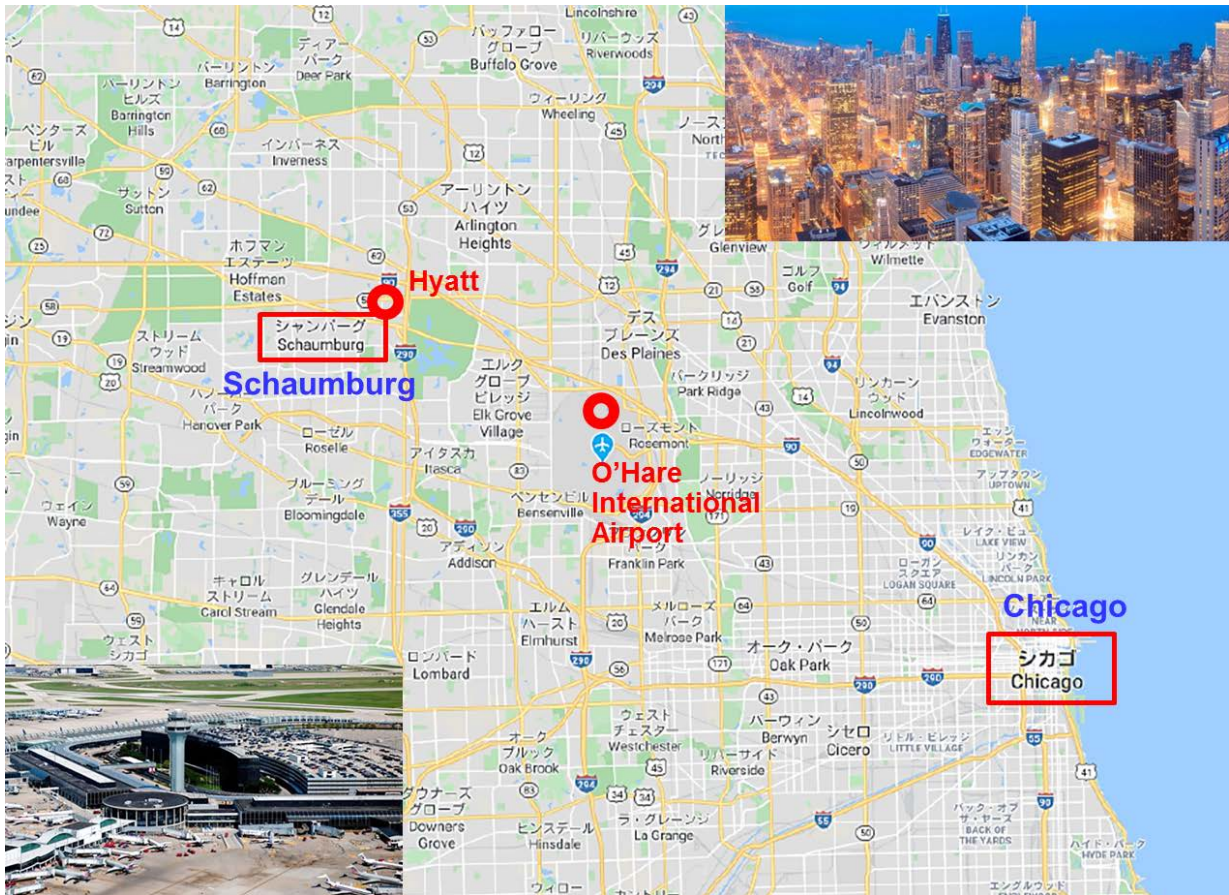

# **JWG N05026 Meeting Report**

## **DRAFT MINUTES OF ISO TC122/TC104 JOINT WORKING GROUP CHICAGO (SCHAUMBERG), ILLINOIS APRIL 21-22, 2005**

### **Thursday, April 21, 2005**

The meeting was convened by Craig Harmon at 9:15 AM.

Members introduced themselves. 19 members in attendance. Attending first meeting was Mr. Mark White, acting as liaison to ISO TC51 (Packaging).

The agenda was reviewed and approved.

Craig outlined the scope and direction of JWG work.

Drafting committee was assigned: Dick Schnacke

Craig reported that ISO 17363 and ISO 17367 are currently out for CD ballot (closing May 26). During the balloting process, no work of consequence can be done with these documents.

Mike Wolfe reported that a debate has been running in the U.S. about placarding hazardous material shipments. The debate is that incident management first responders desire placarding hazardous shipments whereas security advocates desire anonymity for such shipments to minimize the free availability of security-related information. Mike's report stated that US DOT (DHS) has recently expressed its preference for the continued placarding of such shipments. It was also reported that ISO 14815 drafted by ISO TC204 WG7, has just been successfully balloted. This has relevance to our document ISO 17363 since additional bits may be needed in the protocol to accommodate such placarding. An action was assigned to Craig to provide appropriate comment during the 17363 ballot.

Craig reviewed the balloting cycle for our documents. Our future meeting schedule should be built around the balloting and comment resolution needs of these documents. For this reason, the JWG elected to not meet in London in May alongside SC4 WG2. Meetings during late July and late October line up well with document schedules.

### **Review of draft ISO 10374.2**

Lars Lorenzen presented the current draft ISO 10374.2 for review. First issue addressed was document numbering and the issue of withdrawing the current version. The current draft is numbered as ISO 10374:2005 as opposed to ISO 10374.2. Lars stated that this was done with the intention of completely replacing the current version with this new one. Dick Schnacke stated that others, outside of the JWG, may wish to use the existing 10374 as a building block for their work. Dick stated that he would wish to see the existing version withdrawn. The

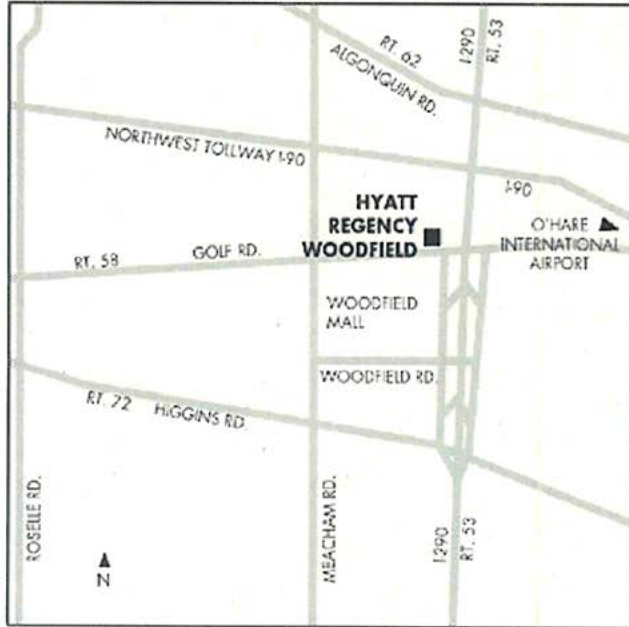

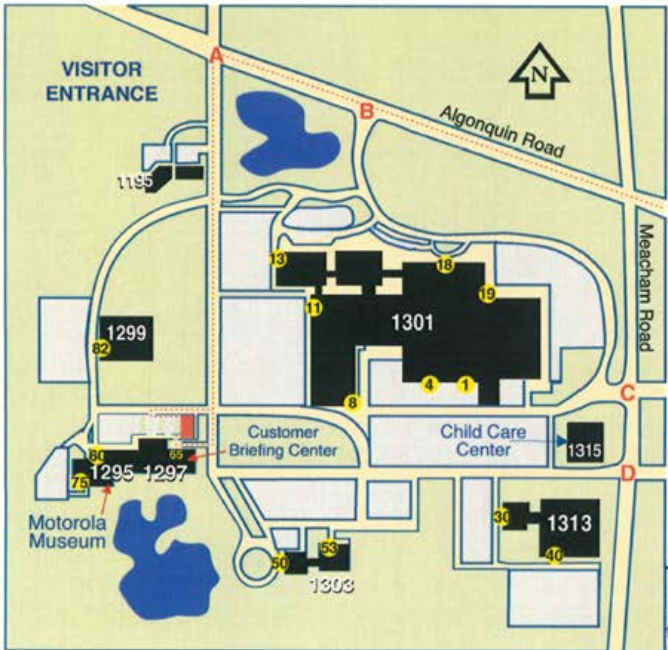

**Directions From Highway:**  
From downtown Chicago, take the Kennedy Expressway west to O'Hare Airport and Rockford.

Follow the Rockford signs to the Northwest Tollway (I-90).

Exit the Tollway at Illinois Rt. 53 north (Rolling Meadows) and remain in the right lane, immediately exit Rt. 53 to Rt. 62 (Algonquin Road). Proceed West several stoplights to the intersection of Algonquin and Meacham Roads at which Motorola Center is located.

The Motorola Center can be entered via the Visitors' Entrance (A) which is located at the West Drive off of Algonquin Road (Rt. 62).

An alternate route from Chicago is by way of the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) West and North, exiting onto Rt. 53 as described above.

From the South take I-355 North to Rt. 53 or I-294 North to I-290 West and North, to Rt. 53 North to Algonquin Road (Rt. 62).
